		<ul> <li>income. \$19M worth of property currently in escrow. Expect to save \$27M from attrition. Only critical positions will be filled.</li> <li>School allocation model – There might be a change in staff as staff gets moved around to maintain current levels of service. There will be centralized health and wellness resources (one nurse per day per week based on school size). Schools will get 40% less for schools to use for supplies. Teacher ratio will increase to 1:27 for grades k-3 only.</li> <li>Counseling support will also be centralized and allocated based on school size.</li> <li>Categorical spending guidelines are being revised.</li> </ul>

DAC Report	• Informational: Melanie Sigler, DAC rep	<ul> <li>Melanie mentioned more about the same meeting that Mrs. Powell attended.</li> <li>A Parent Involvement committee was created to help schools communicate with parents better.</li> <li>Process for schools will be more standardized. Classified staff, nurses, counselors, coaches has to stay the same and will be funded centrally. Can't increase the number of these staff even if you have the money. Mrs. Powell will clarify this at future meetings.</li> <li>Class sizes will increase as attrition losses will not be replaced. Parents and Principals concerned.</li> <li>School safety plans have been completed for each school and are posted on the website.</li> <li>Created a new executive committee of the DAC.</li> <li>There is a budget workshop that occurred that is on the website for review.</li> <li>School Accountability Report Cards are posted on the district website.</li> </ul>
7. Public Comment	• Open	<ul> <li>There is a balance in the Parent Involvement account. Mrs. Powell asks parents what they would like to use it for. March 4, 6-7:30pm a special seminar will be presented for parents on Autism and Downs. Are there ideas for more seminars? Mrs. Powell will send out a survey to parents.</li> <li>New dismissal plan is working. There has been negative and positive feedback but overall is has been positive. This new plan was the site's response to recent school shootings. Looking at changing the front curb to drop off only, not 3 minute parking.</li> </ul>
