ELA and Math Benchmark Review	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Informational: Rita Powell, Principal 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Science Benchmark 2 results: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 3rd grade 93% proficient and advanced, benchmark 1 was 85% ○ 4th grade 81%, last time was 82% ○ 5th grade 85%, last time was 80% ○ Average for benchmark 1 was 82% and average for benchmark 2 was 86% ○ Goal is 90% • There is a correlation between benchmarks and CST's • Mrs. Powell got feedback on the board acknowledging those students that received proficient and advanced. Some parents didn't like that student names were listed. This time the results will be shown as a pie chart by grade level instead of listing individual names.

Public comment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Information Item 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Mrs. Powell asked for feedback on the new security system. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Teachers and parents are feeling more comfortable with the system, thank you to the Mr. Keith and Mr. Williams for helping the system work more smoothly ○ District safety and security committee will visit schools to evaluate security measures and school climate ● Problems with parents parking, drop off and utilizing the parking lot incorrectly ● Board of Education will be voting on going to a common calendar starting in FY15 – will be a hybrid of year round and traditional schedule for ALL schools ● Meatless Mondays was approved by the Board of Education. ● Mrs. Powell was on a committee that designed a district survey asking parents how they feel about their school, is it a quality school? Jones is the only seminar school in this neighborhood, a workshop to highlight our GATE/seminar program will be organized. Jones is also the only AVID school in Serra Mesa. Mrs. Powell will also do a survey specific to Jones and how we can best meet parent’s needs. ● Excess teachers – we will be losing 2 teachers due to excessing. Mrs. Powell will confirm if they must go to other schools or if they can stay on campus.
