Jones got 79.4% in ELA, 84.1% in Math and 93.2% in Science. English learners are the sub-group that needs the most improvement. District's Adequate Yearly Progress goal is 100% in 2014. Goal in 2012 is 78.4% for ELA and 79% for Math – we accomplished that goal this year, but next year will be challenging.

By 8/31/13, the goal is <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ ELA scores to increase from 79% to 90% ○ ELA for English learners will increase from 46% to 60% ○ Math goal is to increase from 84% to 94% ○ Math for English learners will increase from 70% to 79% These goals apply to each quarter benchmark period. A section of the

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		<p>SPSA is dedicated to how the budget will support each of the goals set forth, such as purchasing software programs, classroom materials, classroom library materials, staff to provide support to classrooms, professional development, and conferences. Mrs. Powell will provide at a future meeting the restrictions and specifications with each funding source. There is a parent involvement and community engagement goal to get 80% of parents/guardians to participate in at least 2 school events. To measure participation at events, tickets can be given out to each family to count attendance. It was moved and seconded to approval the SPSA.</p>

It was moved and seconded to approve the transfer.

The District is looking to closing the gap between Hispanic and white students. It was discussed on how to target those gaps and how to use existing Title I monies to provide support and help achieve goals. The level of accountability among schools with the parents varies among the district. Mrs. Powell would like to request funds for parent involvement. Melanie will provide information on an artificial turf field and more about the DAC at the next SSC meeting. Mrs. Powell will email the SSC meeting schedule to the members.
