Data Review</p> <p>➤ SBAC Data</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rita Powell 	<p>The principal shared with the members the difference between the STAR testing base in the California State Standards and the new SMARTER Balanced testing based on the Common Core that involves new standards for example critical thinking in Literacy and Math. The principal explained that in 2013-2014 the school and districtwide had a pilot SMARTER Balanced testing, just to get the students and teachers ready. The results were not deliver to parents or used to evaluate the student performance. Budget ➤ Budget Transfer ➤ Budget 30103 Title I Parent Involvement Spending Plan</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mrs. Rita Powell 	<p><u>The Principal presented the SBAC 14-15 results for Math:</u></p> <p>From All students 48% Met the Standard in Math. The District Wide percentage was 41%. Jones is above the district percentage.</p> <p><u>The Principal presented the SBAC 14-15 results for ELA:</u></p> <p>From All students 57% Met the Standard in ELA. The District Wide percentage was 51%. Jones is above the district percentage.</p> <p>Also members read the information and pointed at the schools in our Cluster that scored higher than us and mentioned the possibility of visiting these sites. One of them was within our cluster, Chesterton. The other school was Sessions that is out of our cluster.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mrs. Powell informed the members about the Resource 00000 (Discretionary) and when the Budget was developed the amount of \$6,000 was allocated under the substitute 1192 classification. The school right now needs more supplies like copy paper and toners, she has decided to move some of this money under supplies in the same resource. • Mrs. Kim Petersen moved to the next Agenda Item that was the Title I Parents Involvement money resource 30103. The allocation for this resource is \$1,008. The principal explained how this money was expend on previous years. She mentioned that she hired a speaker for the parents etc. <p>Mrs. Petersen proposed to expend the money providing daycare for siblings of the students, so parents will have some time to help in the school in different ways. It was proposed to create a survey with ideas so parents could vote in how to expend this money. For example members mentioned to add in the survey to expend the money in Coffee for the parent's room, or refreshments for parents.</p> <p>Mrs. Reshes proposed the idea of having the Family Night at Jones and used the money for the things to be used during this Family Night, example calculators, etc.</p>
